


- 3 Place all of your objects on a flat surface in order to arrange them.




Most Importantly:

TRY DRAWING A ROBOT WITH THE

SHAPES THAT YOU SEE IN THIS IMAGE.

- 1) Start with a square with rounded corners for the head
- 2) Then add a neck
- 3) Then add the body. See how the body has angled lines it is not exactly square
- 4) Then add legs by stacking drawings of squares and rectangles
- 5) Next add arms with angled lines.
- 6) Last add hands. Maybe your robot hands are not circle style like this one?






