Activity #1 SILHOUETTE PORTRAITS:



How to draw the outline.



What to add inside your outline.



What You Do:

- 1) Tape a piece of white or light color paper to the wall in a dark room.
- 2) Place a flashlight on a table.
- 3) Sit between the **light** and the paper so that your profile appears on the paper.
- 4) Have a parent, adult, or older sibling trace around your **silhouette** onto the paper.
- 5) Remove the paper from the wall and **make** sure your lines are smooth.
- 6) Now you can add anything you want inside the outline. Cut out papers from magazines. Words, color, shapes, lines, patterns.
- 7) **HAVE FUN CREATING YOUR AMAZING PROJECT!**

Materials:

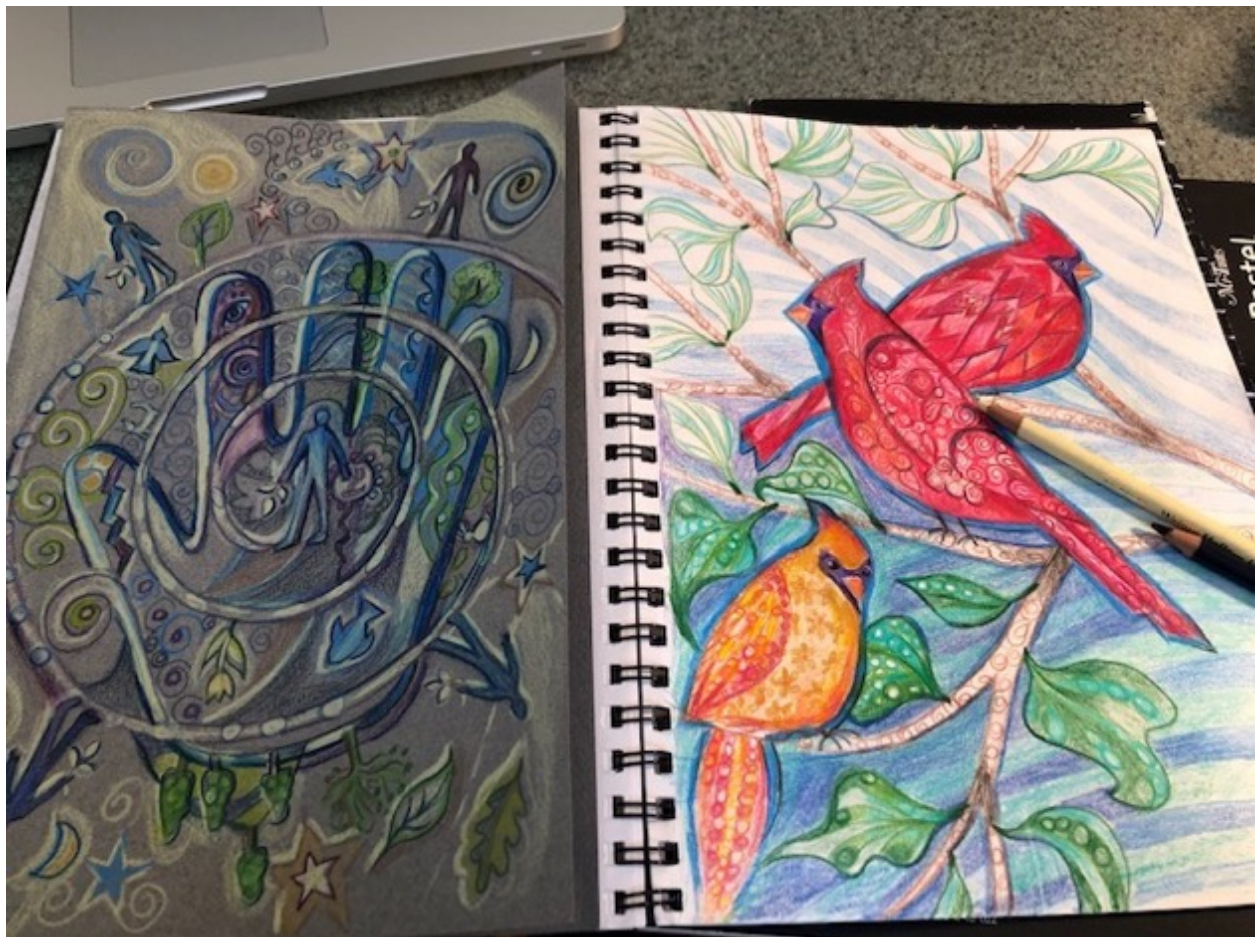
You will need a pencil, paper, an eraser if needed, and any materials you have to add color such as color pencils, crayons, and markers.

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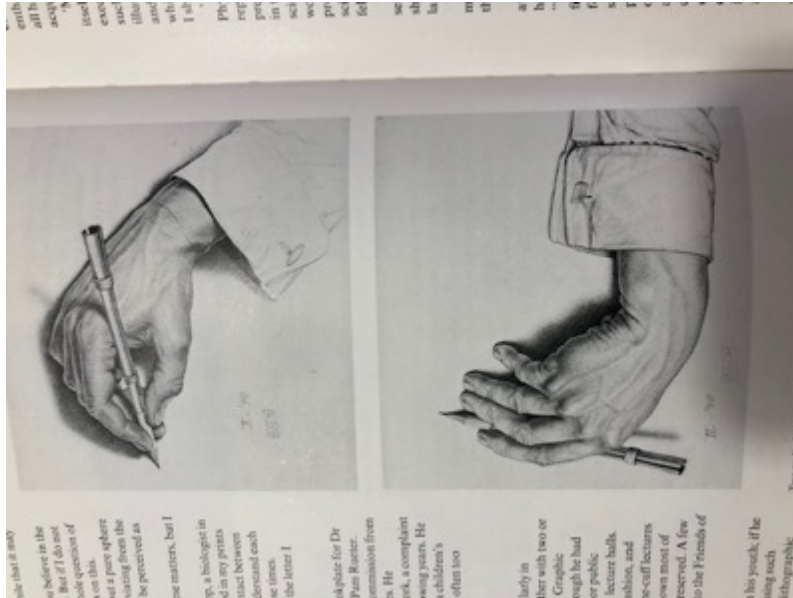

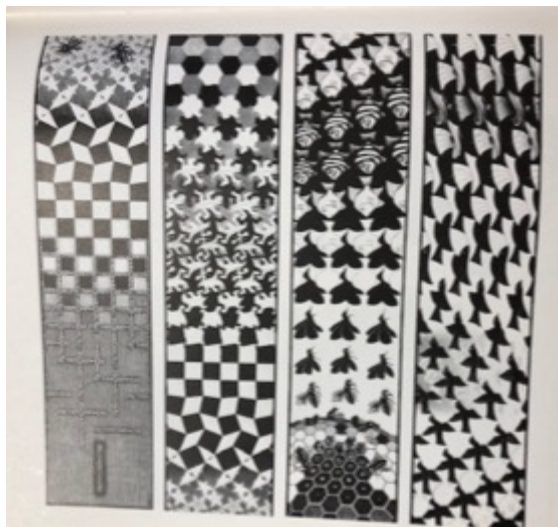
Activity #4 M.C. ESCHER:
