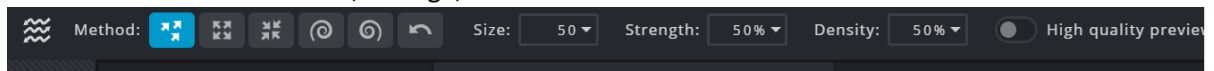
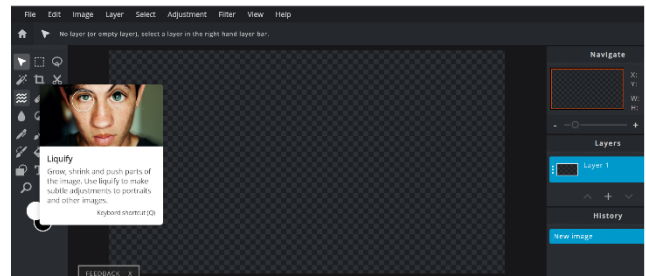

1. Open camera and take one picture of yourself (not silly faces or gestures)
2. In pixlr click file and open image and locate your photo We are only morphing our own picture!
3. Using the toolbars on the right chose liquify
4. These are the methods Push, enlarge, shrink and Swirl



5. Click on one control and then on your picture, (you can change the size of your control by clicking the size option in the method bar) manipulate your image ! Have fun

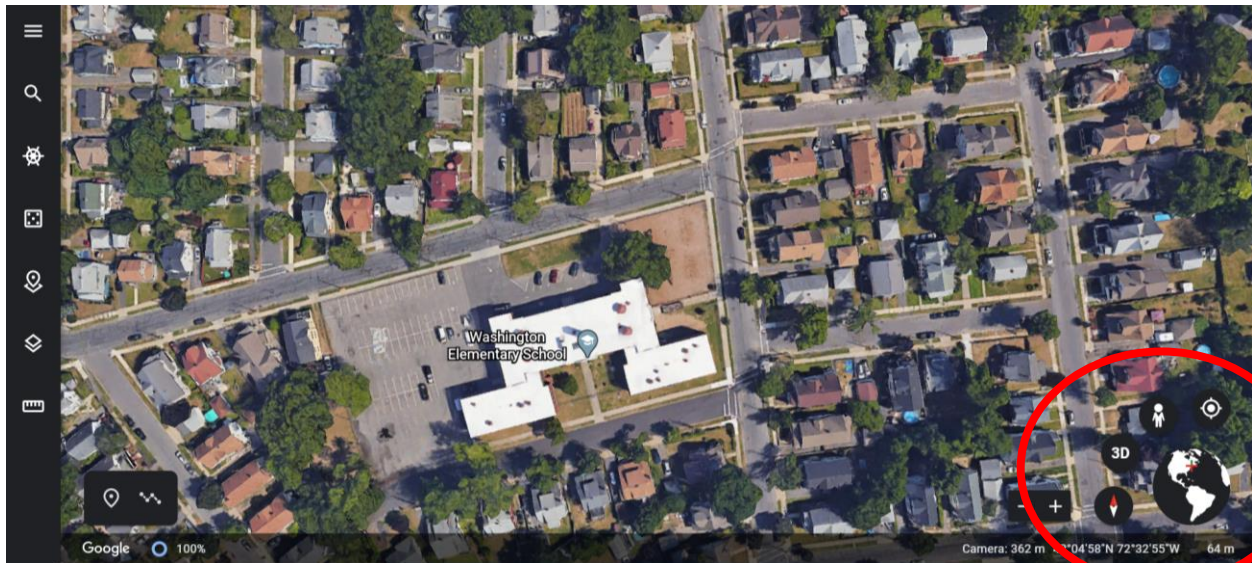

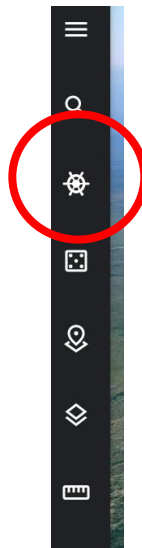
Using the tools in the corner Fly to your location explore your neighborhood.
